<p>Raised mire, marshy grassland and semi-improved meadows in Dunnerdale. The mire is dominated by bog myrtle with bog asphodel, marsh violet, purple moor-grass, devil's bit scabious, bog mosses, rushes, heather, cross-leaved heath, cranberry, common cotton grass, sundew and bilberry. The marshy grassland is dominated by purple moor-grass with rushes, oval sedge, tormentil, angelica, bog myrtle and other grass species. The meadows are dominated by a good range of neutral grass species with yarrow, common knapweed, marsh thistle, autumnal hawkbit, selfheal and meadow buttercup.</p>
