### Toad patrols

- Native amphibians (esp toads) migrate back to ponds to mate
- Estimated 20 tonnes are killed on roads leading to massive decline
- 2021 study classified common toads (Bufo bufo) as Near threatened in Great Britain  $\square$ 
  - C NT > VU EN CR EW EX
- Toad patrollers help them at known crossing points
- · Variety of methods can be used depending on site
