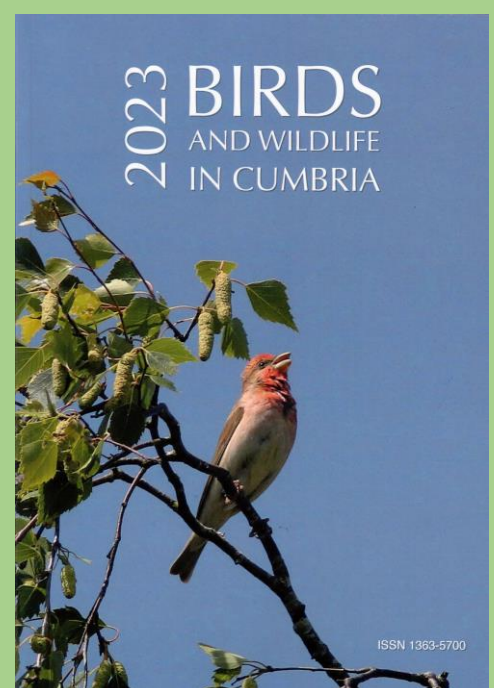
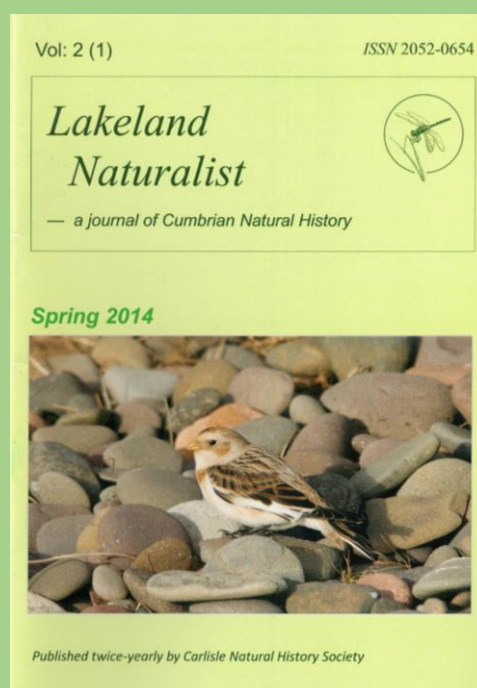
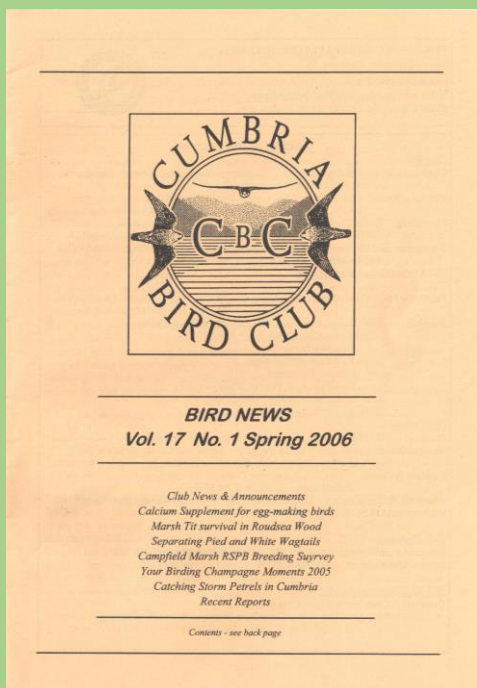

Introduction

This report is a compilation of material on the ornithology of Cumbria published between 2000 and 2024 inclusive, and follows the form and structure of earlier parts of this series of bibliographies dealing respectively with material published between 1500 and 1899 (Part A) (Sellers *et al* 2020a), 1900 and 1949 (Part B) (Sellers *et al* 2020b) and 1950-1999 (Part C) (Sellers *et al* 2024). It has been drawn up primarily on the basis of systematic searches of local and national ornithological publications and taking into account the material contained in two earlier bibliographies, one by the Cumbria Bird Club published in 2014, and the other by A.F.Armsby in 2015.

As with earlier parts in this series, the intention has been to cite full bibliographic details (as would be

required in a peer-reviewed journal, say) though some details are wanting in certain instances (indicated by a question mark in square brackets). Every effort has been made to checking spellings *etc* and any oddities that remain are as in the original. Where necessary additional information is given briefly in square brackets after the main citation, in particular indicating which species are dealt with in the text if this is not obvious from the title. Also given, where known, are details of how to obtain copies of the material referenced either with the citation (again in square brackets) or for more general publications such as serials, as shown in Appendix 9.

No attempt has been made here to distinguish between high quality publications and more run of the mill material, although it is clear that the quality varies considerably. Nor can we vouch for the correctness of

any of the publications – user beware!

Whilst a great deal of effort has been put into identifying the items included, it is almost inevitable in a work of this nature that some material has been overlooked, or that errors have crept in. We are acutely aware, for instance, that no systematic survey of the county's newspapers, has been undertaken, and it would not be surprising if articles from this source remained to be found. We note also in passing that full bibliographic details are wanting from much of the material shown in Appendix 6 – this is very much a work in progress. We hope to include a more complete set of these details in future issues. The authors would be pleased to hear of any new material (no matter how brief or trivial it may seem), or of any corrections that need to be made, omissions, or suggestions for improvement.

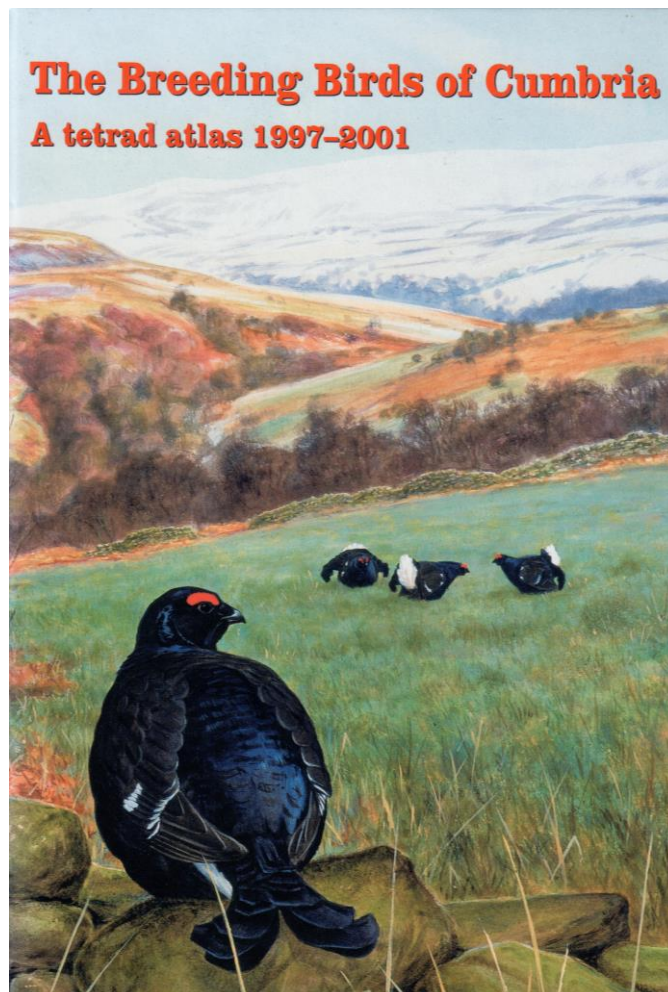

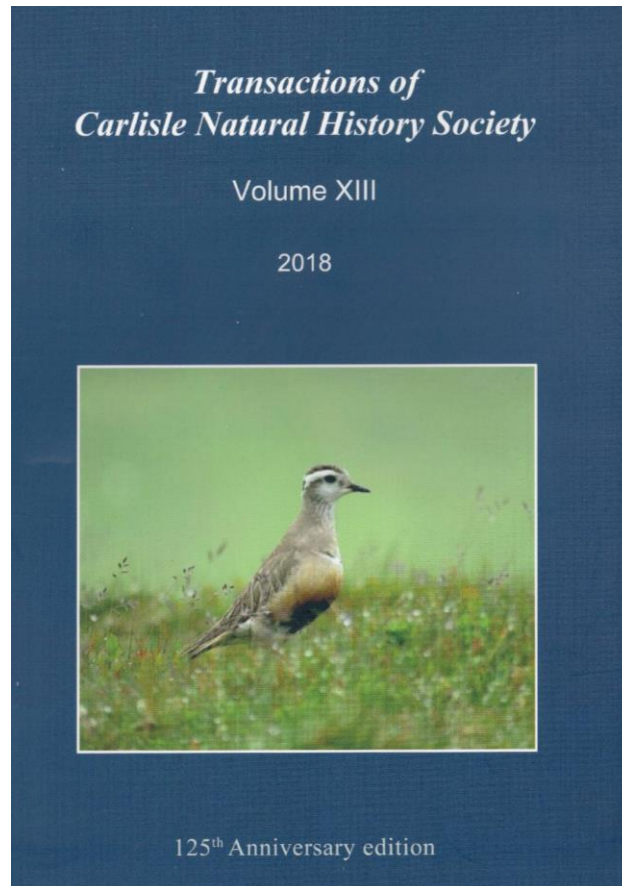
